ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

Teachers in partner Schools, Orphanages and Shelters exchanges email with Seafarers once a week for 10 weeks

ROLE: Coordinate weekly communication with seafarers onboard and conduct pre- and post-tests/surveys with the children.

COORDINATORS

Match Seafarers and Teachers. Explain program to Teachers including monitoring and evaluation system and tools, including pre and post-test tool.

ROLE: Act as the liaison between schools, manning companies, teachers, and seafarers, ensuring seamless communication and effective project management.



SEAFARERS ONBOARD

Participating seafarers will encourage the young generation to consider a Maritime Professional Career.

Role: Share onboard experiences meaningfully and responsibly through weekly email exchanges with the assigned teacher.
