ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

Teachers in partner Schools, **Orphanages and Shelters** exchanges email with Seafarers once a week for 10 weeks

ROLE: Coordinate weekly communication with seafarers onboard and conduct pre- and posttests/surveys with the children.



SEAFARERS ONBOARD

Participating seafarers will encurage the young generation to consider a Maritime Professional Career.

Role: Share onboard experiences meaningfully and responsibly through weekly email exchanges with the assigned teacher.

COORDINATORS

Match Seafarers and Teachers. Explain program to Teachers including monitoring and evaluation system and tools, including pre and post-test tool.
